**Families receive support and resources through our Intensive Family Preservation services, so they can provide stable, loving care for children without further intervention.**

Working alongside the Illinois DCFS, our staff provide counseling, in-home visits, and case management services to prevent the need for out-of-home placement.

#### **PRESENTING ISSUES MAY INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:**

- Domestic violence
- Substance abuse
- Neglect
- Physical or emotional abuse
- Environmental neglect
- Medical neglect
- Mental health
- Child behavioral issues

Services are typically provided for six months or more, depending on the needs of the family. During that time, Bethany caseworkers ensure children are safe, while working to resolve the issues that put them at risk of harm.

#### **INTACT FAMILY SERVICES OFFERS:**

- Case management: Caseworkers monitor families weekly.
- Substance abuse treatment programs: Referrals for both inpatient and outpatient drug rehab treatment.
- In-home counseling: Weekly counseling for adults, children, couples, and families.
- Advocacy: For families involved in the court system and for children in their schools.
- Parenting advice: Age-appropriate expectations and parenting support.
- Community support: Referrals to community services, including medical services, counseling, drug/alcohol treatment support groups, food pantries, housing, employment training, and education programs.
- Crisis services: Available 24/7.
